Application Process

We are excited to announce the opening of the application process for grades 6th, 7th, and 8th for the 2012-2013 school year. Please ask your counselor to identify students in grades 5th, 6th, and 7th that may be eligible based on the criteria outlined below. Complete the application, and return by February 29, 2012.

- Invitation and Acceptance is based on 2011 SAT-10 and ARMT scores.
- Students must score at the 50th percentile or above on the 2011 SAT-10 Reading and Math to be considered for the Alternative Program.
- Students who make application to the 8th grade must have successfully completed pre-algebra in the 7th grade.
- The size of each class will be based on the state mandated class size guidelines. Scores are ranked from the highest to the lowest score. Students are invited to enroll by the order of their ranking number, beginning with the highest number, until all vacancies are filled.
