Scholarship Application and Guidelines

The Jefferson/Shelby County Metro Alumni Association annual scholarship program will be awarded to the high school senior(s) and/or current college student(s) who best meet the requirements set forth by the scholarship committee. Scholarship awards are limited to cover tuition, books, and fees; however, the amount of each scholarship award will be determined by the available funds and for students who demonstrate the greatest need for financial support.

The scholarship committee will review and score all scholarship applications that are received, and reserves the right to contact each reference listed within the scholarship application and/or to schedule an interview with the scholarship application and his/her parent(s).

Basic Guidelines for Eligibility

The scholarship opportunity is open to Jefferson and Shelby County high school seniors who are graduating as well as students from these counties who are currently enrolled at Alabama State University. If a scholarship award is given, the award will be paid to Alabama State University and applied towards targeted assistance (i.e. tuition, books, and fees).

Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. High School student who is currently admitted to Alabama State University and plans to enroll on a full time basis (i.e. 12 semester hours or greater) **AND**
- 2. Must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or greater on a 4.0 scale,

OR

3. Must be currently enrolled at Alabama State University and in good academic standing.

Scholarship applicants should specifically state any **special** financial needs on their scholarship application that may not be obvious to the scholarship committee.

Scholarship applicants who have completed one full academic year at Alabama State University are not required to submit a high school transcript.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. All questions must be answered with complete sentences. Incomplete applications will be **returned to the applicant** with no further action by the scholarship committee. (Please use N/A to indicate not applicable or that you are not able to answer the question)
- 2. Applications must be typeset using Arial or Times New Roman font no less than 11 point. Handwritten scholarship applications will be returned to the applicant with no further action by the scholarship committee. The scholarship application will be provided as requested.
- 3. Attach additional sheets as needed in order to complete questions 5, 6, 7, and 8. High school students should answer parts a, b, and c on question 7; college students should only answer part c.
- 4. Applications must include the following:
 - o Completed scholarship application form, including essay
 - Two character references with complete contact information for each (on application form)
 - o A copy of your most recent high school and/or college transcript
 - o A copy of the award letter issued by the Office of Financial Aid (college students)
