SUBJECT: Joint Resolution on Heavy Backpacks

Each year the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) provides information on enacted law regarding Alabama School Health. The local education agency (LEA) has the responsibility for ensuring that compliance and awareness of the law is provided to staff, parents and/or legal guardians, and students.

On February 28, 2017, former Governor Robert Bentley signed Joint Resolution 8 urging all school administrators, teachers, parents, and students to take precautionary health measures related to the potential impact of the use of heavy backpacks.
