Dismissal Procedures

W.J. Christian Charger's welcome to the 2019-2020 school year. We are committed to the goal of providing safe and positive transportation for all our students. As a team of students, parents, drivers, and staff working together, our safety goal will be achieved. Listed below are the procedures that we will follow for the various ways our students are dismissed from school.

Transportation Arrangements:

- If you need to make a one-day change to your student's dismissal plan, you will need to either send a written note to school or email their teacher. If we do not receive this notification by 2:00pm, your student will need to follow their normal dismissal routine.

Bus Students- Middle School bus riders will walk from their classrooms to the front-loading zone to enter the bus.

Walkers- All walkers must report to a designated area within the school to walk home with an assigned W. J. Christian staff member. The group will walk to the bottom of the hill at the intersection of Gravelee and Mountain Drive. Where parents should be standing to meet students. Walking students will need their walking pass in their backpack at all times. PARENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO PARK OR WAIT IN THEIR CAR IN THE MIDDLE OR THE SIDE OF THE ROAD TO PICK UP THEIR CHILD...THIS IS A MAJOR SAFETY ISSUE. IN CASE OF EXTREMELY BAD WEATHER, PLEASE MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR YOUR CHILD TO ARRIVE HOME SAFELY.

Carpool – A copy of the student dismissal plan will be sent home with students who are carpool riders. This will make the process much faster. Parents who plan to go through the carpool line must have a nameplate with student and teacher name in the driver side window. Parents must adhere to the carpool route for K-4 and 5-8. Parents are NOT to leave or park cars in the carpool line. Carpool students with middle and elementary siblings will be picked up on the K-4 Dismissal route. Middle school students with an elementary sibling will report to the gym during dismissal.

Parent Check out –There will be no checkouts after 2:30 pm.
