



# Remote Learning Technology

<b>Remote Learning</b>	<p>Remote Learning occurs when the learner and instructor are separated by time and distance and therefore cannot meet in a traditional classroom setting. BCS will provide remote learning in three different ways:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Teacher led instruction using printed student work provided to students</li><li>2. Teacher full digital instruction</li><li>3. Teacher led blended instruction (a combination of printed student work and digital instruction)</li></ol>
<b>Enrichment</b>	<p>Birmingham City Schools will continue to provide instruction to all students. Those students who have passed all of their classes based on the average of the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Nine weeks grades, will be provided enrichment. Instruction and teacher support will still occur, but grades will not be given.</p>
<b>Grade Improvement</b>	<p>Students who have failed the third nine weeks OR students who would like to improve their grade have the opportunity to redo coursework using an online option or paper/pencil classwork.</p>
<b>Credit Recovery</b>	<p>Students in grades 9-12 who have failed a class have the opportunity to redo coursework or retake a course through alternate means and thereby avoid failure and earn academic credit.</p>
