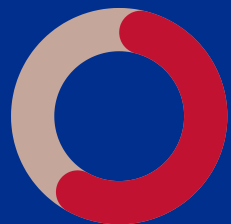

There are 3 classes to complete the Cosmetology Pathway:



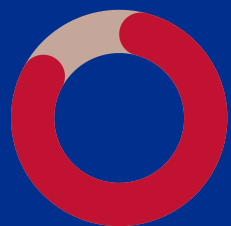
